Once every 3 years the WAFL conference is held, an international conference on the assessment of animal welfare on the farm, during transport and slaughter. This year, Wageningen University & Research and VHL University of Applied Sciences brought the event to the Netherlands: 5-8 September 2017 in the Reehorst conference centre in Ede.

On September 5, 2017, an 'Innovation Day' will take place, where innovative ideas are presented regarding concepts or systems that improve the welfare of farm animals in practice. Conference participants from both industry and science do this in short pitches, or at an innovation market. The contributions range from new, innovative ideas to developed housing concepts, management innovations or PLF techniques developed recently.

In addition to conference participants also other interested parties are kindly invited. We invite especially young entrepreneurs and start-ups to present their products and get acquainted with (international) scientists.
