Courses available to exchange students	<p>Incoming exchange students are required to register for 30 credits per semester, with at least 15 credits at the Faculty of Science. Course eligibility is based on fulfillment of the course prerequisites.</p> <p>Important! Students need to think carefully when making the study plan and study each course syllabus thoroughly to make sure they fulfill the requirements. Level of courses	Exchange students are normally allowed to take courses on both bachelor's (undergraduate) and master's level (graduate) if requirements are met.
Full time course load per semester	<p>30 credits ("hp") per semester is considered full time. 60 hp per year.</p> <p>Maximum course load per semester is 30 credits plus one 7,5 credits Swedish (SVEE) course.</p>
Language requirements	It is important that the student has sufficient proficiency in English language to be able to study the courses open to exchange students. It is <i>recommended</i> that the student has a proficiency corresponding to IELTS 6.5 / TOEFL 90 / B2.
