## The role of Wageningen Bioveterinary Research in research into bird flu

Wageningen Bioveterinary Research (WBVR) is the top institute for research into avian influenza, also known as bird flu. WBVR tests both material from poultry farms in the monitoring programme, and material from farms where bird flu is suspected. WBVR also examines samples from dead wild birds and waterfowl.

## Working to improve the health of animals and humans

The aim is to identify possible outbreaks of the infection as soon as possible and carry out extra checks on poultry close to the source of the infection. In addition to laboratory testing, WBVR also gives advice about control strategies, makes risk assessments using epidemiological models and compiles risk analyses. This is a vital step in implementing measures to tackle bird flu. Continuous research into developing and administering vaccines is another part of our remit.
