Spring Semester courses begin early January to early February and end late April or June, depending on the track. Subsequent internship or Junior Research Lab extend from early May to the end of June or later depending on the internship.

Training in a Joint Research Unit and Internship at l'Institut Agro Montpellier

Period Internships can begin at any time of the year. Internship may last from 2 to 6 months. Internships of more than two months are remunerated but more difficult to obtain.

Language requirements Proficiency is required in French or in English. In some cases, other languages can be

accepted.

Requirements Official evidence student has completed at least 4 semesters of graduate studies (120 ECTS)

for the tracks given at Florac Campus (B.Sc. 3 level) and 6 semesters (180 ECTS) for the

other tracks

B1/B2 level in French and/or English, depending on the selected track

Nomination and Application

Students should be nominated by their home institution.

Nominated students will receive an email with their login and password.

Application form and documents must be completed/uploaded ONLINE: ID-photo, IDdocument, Transcript of records of higher education, Language certificates in French and/or

English (depending on courses), Cover letter and Application file.
