








Honours kick off excursion week

From Monday 29 August till Friday 2 September 2022 the Honours kick off takes place at Texel (one of the Dutch Wadden-Islands). During this week the focus will be on getting to know each other, leadership introduction and a first brainstorm about your Honours Investigation Project. This week is compulsory.







Broadening: Honours Investigation Project (HIP)

The HIP is the backbone of the BSc. Honours Programme. Students work in interdisciplinary teams of ±7 students towards a self-defined product related to the mission of WU. Students define, persist and finish a long term, selfmanaged project and integrate their disciplinary knowledge in a challenging, multidisciplinary research project. Every team is facilitated by an expert coach.

Broadening: Honours Activities

Activities are student-organised events addressing a self-chosen topic or skill, to be approved by the Programme Director. Activities are organised by the honours staff as well. Students are free in joining the activities.

Activities can be excursions, master classes, presentations, debates, cultural or sport events, creative sessions,.....and often a lot of fun!









Deepening: Honours Cards & Thesis Extension

Honours Cards: Students select 2-4 courses from their regular BSc study programme. Within each of these courses they define an extra complex 2 EC-assignment together with the course teacher. The NAHSS also counts as an honours card.

A tailor-made extra learning outcome (relative to the student's regular BSc thesis) is defined by student and thesis supervisor.

Examples of Cards

- Study complex issues in your own field of research
- Improvement of a study course
- Scientific publications
- Elaboration of various perspectives on your thesis topic
- Fieldwork by testing the theory studied in a course







Personal development

The learning goal for personal development is to show a purposefully self-directed personal development. A personal tutor helps the student with their reflections.

The learning goal for the Leadership track is to identify and develop your own authentic leadership style, and experience leadership by joining a 'leader' for one day at their work place.
