About the role

The LEAF & Climate role focuses on improving the sustainability of WUR's operations. This role includes carrying out projects related to LEAF (Laboratory Efficiency Assessment Framework), energy, circularity, and climate. The aim is to reduce the environmental impact of the university and create a sustainable environment for all students and staff.

The Laboratory Efficiency Assessment Framework (LEAF) is a key part of this role. This initiative is aimed at enhancing the sustainability and efficiency of education and research laboratories at WUR by encouraging collaboration, sharing of best practices and challenges, and implementation of sustainable solutions.

Additionally, this position offers the opportunity to develop and implement new sustainability projects to further reduce WUR's climate impact.

Key Responsibilities

As a LEAF Co-Coordinator

- Co-Organize and lead events / sessions to discuss progress, share ideas, and address challenges
- Conduct and arrange audits / lab visits, be active in the LEAF network
- Collate and bring together current, disjointed efforts at more sustainable labs in WUR
- Introduce sustainable practices in labs to students at an early stage
- Share protocols for improving sustainability in labs with the whole WUR community through dialogues, hybrid lectures and workshops

As a Green Office Coordinator

- Identify and implement new projects to reduce WUR's climate impact
- Join Facilities & Services (FB) working groups related to energy, circularity and climate
- Co-Organize events to engage student community with Green Office projects
- Recruit and coordinate volunteers



Who are we looking for?

- Someone passionate about sustainability and who wants to improve the sustainability of WUR's operations through the implementation of different projects and initiatives
- Ability to take initiative and create ideas for engaging projects and carry them out
- Interest and ability to skillfully engage in conversations with various types of people, from students to staff members and policy makers
