


Alumni are divided into three groups:

Characteristics of MIL alumni








Positions held by MIL alumni

Recent graduates often work in different organisations to those who graduated some time ago. For example, recent MIL graduates are more likely to work at consultancy firms, while those who have been in employment longer are more likely to have jobs at other organisations.
