Paris-Saclay

- Located on vast territory in the South of Paris
- Université Paris-Saclay is nestled in a protected natural area at the very heart of a dynamic economic hub.
- Climate: the average temperature in winter is 3-8 C° and in summer it is 20-30 C°



The cost of living in the Paris region

- Renting a shared apartment: 600 - 700 €
- Renting a private studio: 700 - 900€
- Renting a room in a student residence (CROUS): 200 - 500 € (Limited places)
- Public transport: The RER is the mode of transport most often used by students : 375€ per year

STUDY at Paris-Saclay

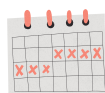


- **Possible types of exchanges:**
