	Application Procedure
Nomination deadlines	<p>For full year (September-June): 1 May Semester 1 (September-February): 1 May Semester 2 (February-June): 15 October</p> <p>Once nominated, and after we have been provided with contact details, we will email students directly and provide them with a PIN and all the other necessary information in order to successfully complete their applications through the UMH online incoming application platform (Mobility Online Application Account).</p>
Application deadlines	<p>For full year semester (September-June): 15 May Semester 1 (September-February): 15 May Semester 2 (February-June): 1 November</p>
Documents required for application	<p>For your Application Form to be considered completed, you will have to fill in all the required information fields and upload a color copy of the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Learning Agreement. ▪ Updated Transcript of Records. ▪ National Identity Card (EU citizens) or Passport (non-EU citizens or when ID card is not compulsory in an EU country). ▪ European Health Insurance Card (EU citizens) and/or evidence of private health insurance cover (optional - EU citizens; obligatory - non-EU citizens). ▪ Spanish Language Certificate or equivalent certificate (Erasmus coordinators or competent authorities of the home university/institution or Language Centre may authenticate the student's ability in the Spanish language).

- One color photograph (3x4 cm) with a white background or a similar computer file image.
- Curriculum Vitae.
- Bachelor's degree diploma and/or certification of present registration in Master's course (only applicable to Master's level students).

*[Level B2 DELE](#) or equivalent certificate is required from students applying for studies in bachelors' degrees in Medicine, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, and Podiatry, plus all Masters' courses where teaching is in Spanish.

Once you have provided us with all necessary documents, duly authorized by the student's Erasmus Coordinator, we will send applications to the UMH Faculty for consideration and will later notify possible acceptance of applicants by sending back scanned copies of accepted Learning Agreements and Application Forms, together with an online Letter of Acceptance.

Important! Non-EU citizens must get their [Visas](#) or Residence Permits in their country of residence or home countries before their departure for Spain. Students must be sure about expiration dates, applications for extension deadlines and other relevant dates with the Spanish embassy or consulate.

**Health insurance
requirements**

Students coming from within the European Union with access to the public health system in their home countries will be able to use their [European Health Insurance Card](#). This card entitles students to any necessary healthcare during a temporary stay in any of the [EU member states](#) or in countries from the [European Economic Area](#), at any outpatient department or health center near their accommodations.

Students coming from a non-EU country must bring their own international medical insurance policy to cover their healthcare needs in Spain. Students should also bring an insurance company document detailing the extent of such coverage.

Students coming from countries that have signed [Bilateral Health Agreements](#) with Spain should bring their corresponding documentation with them from their home country and apply to be assigned a general practitioner physician at the health center nearest to their accommodations.
