Nominating mobility students

A mobility student at FEUP can stay for a maximum of two semesters. At the time of the student's selection process, the Home Institution with a specific bilateral agreement with FEUP must consider:

- FEUP's study programmes covered by the agreement(s);
- The mobility numbers established in the agreement(s);
- Duration of the mobilities.

When receiving the nominations from the Home Institution, FEUP's Mobility Team will provide students with the necessary instructions.

NOMINATION'S PERIOD

1st semester (Autumn): Till 12 May 2025

2nd semester (Spring): Till 2 October 2025

We recommend all Partner to send us student nominations by e-mail, identifying the Institution and the ERASMUS+ code in the subject line. The nomination must take into account the scientific agreed areas and the ISCED codes.

PERIOD OF APPLICATION

1st semester (Autumn): 1 April to
21 May 2025

2nd semester (Spring): 1 September to
15 October 2025

ACADEMIC CALENDAR

1st semester: September - February

2nd semester: February - July

The academic calendar does not include the [Orientation Days](#) which takes place one week before the start of each semester. All mobility students are invited to participate (no fees are charged).

MOBILITY FOR PLACEMENTS/INTERNSHIPS

The deadline for an "internship/placement" application for FEUP is until 2 months before the start date.

Preparing the study plan

DEGREES AND CREDITS

Undergraduate and graduate:

30 ECTS/semester; 60 ECTS/year

Bachelor's degrees: 3 years, 180 ECTS**Masters' degrees:** 1 year, 60 ECTS; 2 years, 120 ECTS

For mobility students, the recommended workload is 30 ECTS per semester. The maximum workload allowed is 37,5 ECTS per semester and the minimum is 20 ECTS per semester.

COURSES AVAILABLE PER STUDY PROGRAMME

On FEUP's Sigarra, when selecting a specific study programme, relevant information is displayed, namely the respective syllabus. Students can click on each unit course name for information about the lectures, objectives and learning outcomes, the teaching language, pre-requirements, etc.

Students are also able to obtain information about some restrictions in the choice of curricular units, because there may be Programmes or unit courses of some Programmes that are not available for mobility students.

FEUP's study programmes and unit courses may undergo changes before the start of the academic year (1st semester in September/2nd semester in February). The Learning Agreements approved by FEUP may, therefore, be subject to adjustments and changes upon student's arrival and up to 1/2 weeks after the start of the academic year. The specific deadline for submitting changes to learning agreement is communicated to students at the beginning of each semester. Please note that after this deadline no requests are accepted.

When planning the learning agreement, the student must choose only the unit courses that he/she intends to attend and complete, to avoid further unnecessary changes to the agreement.

Students should select as many as possible unit courses from the same study programme to minimize the need for changes.

LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION

Most undergraduate lectures are offered in Portuguese, while most masters subjects are taught in English. At a graduate level provision can be made in some subjects for foreign students to be able to have guidance (contents and bibliography) in English and also do their reports and written examinations in English. However, this will have to be arranged with teachers on a case-by-case basis - these unit courses are referred to as "Suitable for English Speaking Students".

Each academic year an updated list of subjects offered to mobility students may be requested to FEUP's Incoming Mobility Team incoming@fe.up.pt.

International students are advised to learn some Portuguese before coming to Porto (if possible), although this is not mandatory. Please note that students who wish to attend unit courses lectured in Portuguese need to have prior formal knowledge of the language, otherwise they cannot be accepted in these unit courses.

Intensive Portuguese Language Course for Foreigners

Mobility students are welcome to apply online for one of the following beginner's level courses in Portuguese, offered by the U.Porto Faculty of Arts (FLUP) and taught at FEUP:

Portuguese for Foreigners (A1.2)

Intensive Course at Faculty of Engineering of U.Porto

The Intensive Portuguese Language Course is not a unit course, it is an independent and complete course, so it cannot be included in the mobility Learning Agreement/Study Plan.

Students who have attended the classes and passed the final test may request the issue of a Certificate, subject to a fee.

U.Porto allows a student to perform a shared mobility in different Faculties. Please take into account that:

Each U.Porto Faculty has its own management so for particular issues concerning each Faculty unit courses, internal procedures or deadlines you should make a direct contact with the respective Faculty. A student with FEUP as the Main Faculty, must consider that at least 60% of the global amount of ECTS credits in the learning agreement/study plan must belong to FEUP Main Programme covered by the bilateral agreement, correspondent to the student Main Programme in the Home School.
