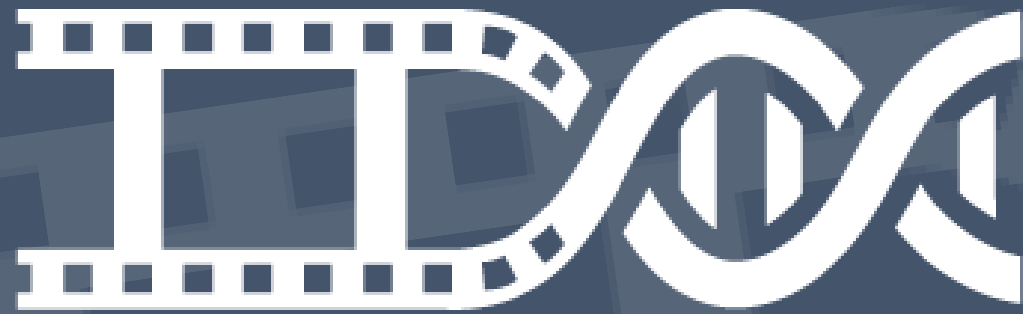

DocuScience



DocuScience

DocuScience is a new program at Omnia, where Wageningen Campus employees share insights into their work. We explore new perspectives through interesting documentaries that prompt conversation.

Setup

Each edition of **DocuScience** is organized in collaboration with a guest programmer. The **guest programmer** chooses the documentary and the format of the program. **DocuScience** and Omnia support in the organization.

The guest programmer is an employee at Wageningen Campus, or has a close connection to WUR. With **DocuScience**, he or she provides a glimpse into his or her work on campus through a documentary.

DocuScience is an accessible program. Registration is not possible. About 100 seats are available and full=full.

Due to the many international employees on campus, **DocuScience** is an English-speaking program.

Standard program

17:30 – 18:45 **DocuDinner in restaurant Novum**

18:30 – 19:00 **Walk-in Auditorium**

19:00 *Start program*

19:00 – 19:15 **Introduction guest programmer/expert**

19:15 – 20:00 **Documentary**

20:00 – 20:30 **Q&A / follow-up discussion with audience about docu and topic**

20:00 *End of program*

20:30 – 21:30 **Optional: drinks at Novum restaurant**

Guidelines documentaries

- Must be available in the Netherlands
- English or English subtitles available
- Preferably a maximum of 45 minutes
- Fits within the budget

Q&A / after talk

After the documentary, there could be time made where the audience can ask questions of the guest programmer and/or possibly an expert.

Guidelines:

- Preferably up to 2 subject matter experts, and preferably no documentary makers.
- After-talk lasts a maximum of 15 minutes. Afterwards, further discussion (at one's own expense) may be held at the bar of Novum restaurant.
- A moderator may be approached to facilitate the conversation.

DocuDinner

Prior to each edition, restaurant Novum offers a DocuDinner.

Cost: €18.25

This includes: main course, dessert, drink.

Guests of the DocuDinner are asked to be present 17:30h in the restaurant.

A seat will be reserved in the auditorium for dinner guests. They are thus guaranteed a (good) seat.

Finances

A maximum of €650 is available per edition of DocuScience.

This will be used to pay for the following:

- Documentary costs
- DocuDinner speakers
- Present speakers

If necessary: extra technique/technical support, travel expenses, etc.)

If a more extensive program is desired, the costs will be covered by the (department/organization of the) guest programmer.

For travel expenses, 19ct per kilometer will be reimbursed.

Publicity

The promotion of each edition is a joint responsibility of DocuScience and the guest programmer.

DocuScience provides:

- Agenda items on WUR webpage, Wageningen Campus webpage and WUR intranet;
- Announcement in the Wageningen Campus newsletter;
- Poster on the narrowcasting screens;
- Possibly an action with YoungWUR.

The guest programmer ensures that the announcement is distributed within his/her network. This can be in person, via email, twitter, linkedin, intranet, etc.

Location & technology

- DocuScience takes place in the Auditorium at Omnia. Here there is room for over 100 people.
- There is a lectern and several desks in the auditorium. Ideally, these should not be pushed aside. Often there is already enough room on the stage.
- If there are multiple speakers, stools can be placed on the stage to give it a talk show setup.
- There is 1 handheld microphone and 1 headset available as standard. More microphones and possibly other technology (video link etc.) is possible, but the cost of this will go off the total budget.
