The grading table requires universities to keep track of their grading practice and culture, which is good practice in many institutions across Europe. The ECTS grading table allows for simple, transparent interpretation and conversion of grades from one system or context to another, and therefore does justice to the level of academic performance of all learners. Used correctly, it bridges different grading systems as well as different cultures in the European Higher Education Area and beyond. The grading table gives the distribution of grades for this specific study period. It presents how many students (in percentages) receive a specific grade. This provides all necessary information to convert the grade in any local grading system.
