Economic Perspectives for a Circular Food System

Capita Selecta - Period 2 (evening lectures) - 3 ECTS

Attention for circular food systems is booming. Now that Dutch agriculture has to move towards circularity, it becomes clear that a lot of questions with regard to the business model for food producers, fair and true pricing along the chain, and the economic system in general, remain unanswered.

Can farmers make a living from circular production?

What does the concept of circular economy imply for food value chains?

Can circularity and economic growth go hand-in-hand?

Together with guest lecturers we will discuss these questions and explore the role of the economy in the transformation towards a circular food system. The course consists of six evening lectures and an essay assignment. The course is organized by the Animal Production Systems group, Agricultural Economics and Rural Policy group, Studium Generale and Wageningen Economic Research.
