

Call for Applications: Comprehensive International Education Program (CIEP).

The **Comprehensive International Education Program (CIEP)** is part of the **Global Education Programs**, where all lectures, field practices, workshops, and related activities are conducted. This program offers an opportunity for both Japanese and international students at Tokyo NODAI, as well as students from our global partner universities, to learn about food, agriculture, and the environment in Japan and Asia. The program is held at the Setagaya Campus and the Hokkaido-Okhotsk Campus in Tokyo and Hokkaido prefectures (Japan) respectively.

This integrated study of agriculture, food, and environmental issues is designed to help students make meaningful contributions toward solving major global challenges faced by humanity in the 21st century.

1. Details of the CIEP 2025

- **Program period:** Saturday, July 26, 2025 - Tuesday, August 5, 2025
- **Place:** Tokyo University of Agriculture, Setagaya Campus (July 26 and August 4-5) and Hokkaido-Okhotsk Campus (Hands-on learning in the field) (July 28 to August 1)
- **Field visits (tentative):** Shiretoko Ezoshika Deer Farm, Abashiri Prison Museum, Shibetsu Salmon Museum, etc.
- **Academic Credits and a certificate of completion from Tokyo University of Agriculture:** 4 undergraduate level credits (from 2 courses listed below) can be earned by those who successfully complete the program
 - Field Study of Food and Environment (2 credits)
 - Sustainable Agriculture in Asia (2 credits)

IMPORTANT NOTE: All expenses related to international airfare and participation in the CIEP must be borne by the participant or his/her home university

2. Participation fee

Approximately, **100,000 yen** (two-way airfare from Tokyo to Hokkaido, accommodation, entrance fees to facilities, etc.). All applicants are required to pay **in cash** upon arrival at Tokyo University of Agriculture, Setagaya Campus.
