

# **Vacancy: Student member Examination Appeals Board (EAB) and Complaints Committee Students**

The Legal Protection Desk Students is searching for you!

## **What is the EAB?**

The EAB handles student appeals against various decisions by the examining boards and the Executive Board. Examples include negative binding study advice, fraud sanctions and examination grades.

The EAB consists of an external chairperson, a (alternating) faculty member, a (alternating) student member and an official secretary. The committee will be involved in appeals when an amicable solution is unsuccessful. Through a hearing, de EAB provides a binding verdict in the matter.

## **What is the Student Complaints Committee?**

The Executive Board of Wageningen University established the Complaints Committee Students in 2021 to promote the legal protection of its students which will be involved when an amicable solution is unsuccessful. Through a hearing the Complaints Committee Students, which is composed of EAB members, provides advice to the Board.

We are currently looking for new student members to take part in both the EAB and the Student Complaints Committee.

## **What is expected of you?**

- Preparing for hearings using the arranged hearing file (30 min. per case);
- Participating in hearings, including pre- and post-hearing discussions (60 min per case). If possible, multiple hearings will be scheduled consecutively on the same day. Hearings will be organized live on campus;
- Depending on the number of hearings, you will be called upon several times a year.

## **Who are we looking for?**

You have:

- Knowledge of (or are willing to acquire this knowledge) various regulations such as the Education and Examination Regulations (OER) and Rules and Guidelines of the Examining Boards;
- Proficiency of the Dutch language in word and writing (English is a big plus);
- An affinity for the legal protection of fellow students;
- A diligent, reliable and discrete work ethic.

Furthermore, you are available for at least one year (preferably longer).

You will receive a fixed fee of € 40,00 per session.
