Institute of Food Economics and Consumption Studies

The Institute includes the Department of Food Economics as well as the Department of Household and Consumer Oriented Health Economics. The teaching and research activities at the Department of Food Economics concentrate on **supply-oriented problems of food markets**. Furthermore, the focus is on the **food security** issues on a global scale and questions of efficient and effective actions to overcome hunger and poverty. The Department of Household and Consumer Oriented Health Economics covers **demand-oriented problems** of the food- and non-food-sector, including the analysis of **consumer behavior** concerning health related consumer protection. Additionally, special attention is paid to **food safety** aspects. This leads into problems of consumer, health and social policy which are strongly interrelated.

Studying in Kiel

The Institute offers courses such as Food Policy, Development Economics, Environmental Economics, and Modeling Consumer Behavior. In combination with the courses of the other Institutes of the Faculty of Agricultural and Nutritional Sciences, there is a broad variety of research and study fields, including Agri Business, Food Science and Human Nutrition, Dairy Economics, Resource Conservation and others.
