


Students say Corvallis is the college town you'll never want to leave — and we certainly can't argue with them! There's a lot to love about this place.







NEWLY DISCOVERED BLUE PIGMENT

WE LOVE MAKING BIG BREAKTHROUGHS.

ESPECIALLY ONES THAT COME OUT OF THE BLUE.

Innovation is embedded into our DNA. Oregon State does more research than the other six public universities in Oregon combined, earning nearly \$440 million in research funding last year. And even as an undergraduate, you can join in. Every year, more than 2,000 undergraduates work alongside faculty researchers or develop projects of their own.

U.S. News and World Report ranked Oregon State No. 1 in the Pacific Northwest for innovation. We're known for engineering and scientific breakthroughs like one of the first robots to stand and walk on two legs, a contact lens that can monitor blood glucose levels and a new strain of seaweed that tastes like bacon when cooked.

But we also blur the lines between science, the arts and the humanities. From a large-scale model intended to understand how spiders sense vibrations, our collaborative researchers created a new musical instrument, the spider harp. And a chemistry professor researching materials for electronics applications ended up producing the first new blue pigment in 200 years. Not only do our artists create paintings using this dazzling new blue, Crayola made it into a new crayon: Bluetiful.



We're ready to welcome you to Beaver Nation. No test required.

Oregon State University has adopted a test-optional admissions policy for first-year students applying for fall 2021 and beyond. You can decide whether or not to take the SAT or ACT and submit these standardized test scores when you apply to Oregon State.

Why are we going test-optional? Oregon State uses a holistic admissions process that looks at all of your accomplishments and potential. It supports our goals for inclusive excellence and fulfills our mission as a land grant university to provide access to a transformative education. And ultimately, it's the right thing to do.

ADMISSIONS CRITERIA

Oregon State University has a holistic admissions process that looks at the following items for every applicant, with the goal of identifying and admitting students who have the skills, abilities and drive to succeed at OSU:

- Your high school grades.
- Rigor of coursework, considered in the context of options available at your school.
- Class rank.
- Grades in any college or dual-credit courses.
- Information provided in your personal statement on the application.
- Your responses to one of our available application essay prompts.

Test scores, if submitted, are never the sole or primary reason for an admissions decision; they are always considered in context and as supplemental information.

OSU neither requires, nor accepts, letters of recommendation except when a student is appealing a denial.



APPLICATION PRIORITY DEADLINES

Your admission application and \$65 nonrefundable fee must be received no later than the dates below to be considered for admission. Applications submitted after Feb. 1 will not be considered for scholarships, but may be considered for admission to the university, based on availability.

Oregon State University offers an online application and accepts the Common Application. We do not have a preference as to which application you choose.

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR NONRESIDENT STUDENTS

- **WUE Scholarship:** Beginning in fall 2021, Oregon State University will be a participating institution in the Western Undergraduate Exchange program. Residents of the following states and territories will be automatically considered for a scholarship that reduces your tuition costs to 150% of resident tuition (renewable for up to four years total): Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, North Dakota, South Dakota, Utah, Washington, Wyoming, Guam and the North Mariana Islands. WUE Scholarships are competitive and awarded based on a holistic review of your application for admission. Not all students from a WUE state will be offered an award. For more details, visit admissions.oregonstate.edu/wue.
- **Provost Scholarship:** Offers up to \$14,000 to nonresident students from any state who do not receive a WUE Scholarship. Provost Scholarships are awarded based on a holistic review of your application for admission (renewable for up to four years total).
- **Diversity Achievement Scholarship:** Offers \$3,000 to students who are actively working to advance diversity, equity, inclusion and social justice on their campuses and in their communities (renewable for up to two years total). To be considered for this competitive award, submit your application through OSU ScholarDollars. Applicants whose parents have not completed a four-year college degree and applicants who have financial need are given preferential consideration.
- **IB Diploma Scholarship:** Offers \$3,000 to students who earn a total score of 30 or higher on the IB exam and complete the IB Diploma (renewable for up to four years total).
- **National Merit Scholarship:** Offers up to \$2,000 for National Merit finalists (renewable for up to four years total).

SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCIAL AID

Oregon State University awards more than \$257 million in scholarships and aid each year. OSU ranks the highest among all Oregon universities in total grant and scholarship dollars awarded and total undergraduates receiving them. Apply for admission early to maximize your scholarship opportunities. Submit your FAFSA before Feb. 28.

You will be considered for most scholarships based on your application for admission, but some require you to apply through OSU ScholarDollars. Visit scholarships.oregonstate.edu for details.

PRE-LAW (3+3)

Through a unique 3+3 partnership, you can complete your first three years at Oregon State, then transfer to Willamette University's College of Law in Salem or the Lewis & Clark Law School in Portland. You'll earn your bachelor's degree and your law degree in six years total.

PRE-MED

You can apply to medical school with any major, as long as required Pre-Med courses are completed. Pre-Med students typically choose majors in Science (BioHealth Sciences, Biology, Biochemistry/Biophysics, Biochemistry/Molecular Biology, Chemistry, Microbiology, Zoology), Engineering (Bioengineering, Chemical Engineering, Radiation Health Physics), Public Health and Human Sciences (Kinesiology, Nutrition, Public Health) and Liberal Arts (History, Music, Psychology, etc.). PRE-PHARMACY

Most Pre-Pharmacy undergraduates choose College of Science majors. A common choice is BioHealth Sciences with a Pre-Pharmacy option.

PRE-VETERINARY MEDICINE

Pre-Veterinary Medicine preparation is available in the College of Agricultural Sciences (Animal Sciences) and the College of Science (Biology).

UNIVERSITY EXPLORATORY STUDIES PROGRAM

You don't have to decide on a major right away. In the UESP, you can assess your career goals, interests and skills, then make well-informed decisions about potential majors while staying on track for graduation.

MARINE STUDIES INITIATIVE

Spend a term or more living and learning on the spectacular Oregon Coast. Venture out on the Pacific Ocean on a research vessel. Study whales, coral reefs, coastal ecosystems and the communities that rely on them. Marine studies can be incorporated into multiple academic programs.

INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMS

Choose from nearly 200 international programs in 70+ countries. Take classes, complete an internship, conduct research or work on a service-learning project. Financial aid and scholarships are available. Oregon State also offers a unique double-degree program in International Studies, which can be paired with any major.
