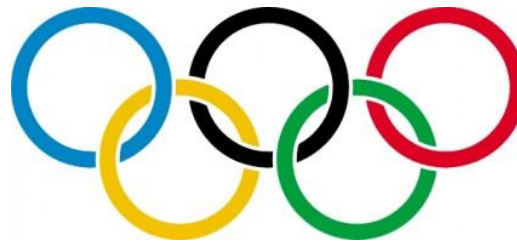


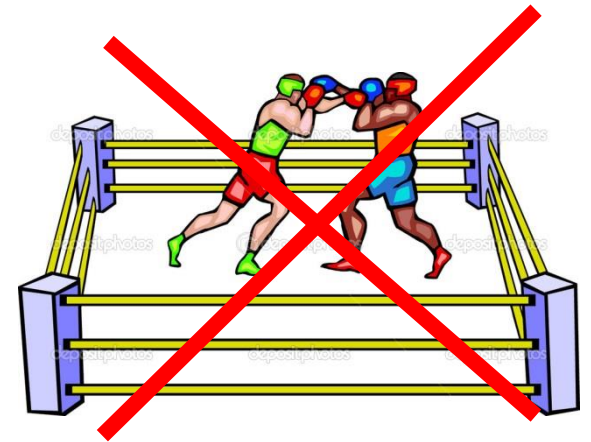
HNE thesis rings

Based on the concept developed by Nematology and other chair groups

Each chair group has one or more thesis rings:

- 1: Sensory Science (SSEB)
- 2: Nutrition and Disease (NAD)
- 3: Nutrition and Health over the Lifecourse (NHL)
- 4: Nutrition, Metabolism and Genomics (NMG)
- 5: Nutrition and Pharmacology (N&P) (*only for labwork*)



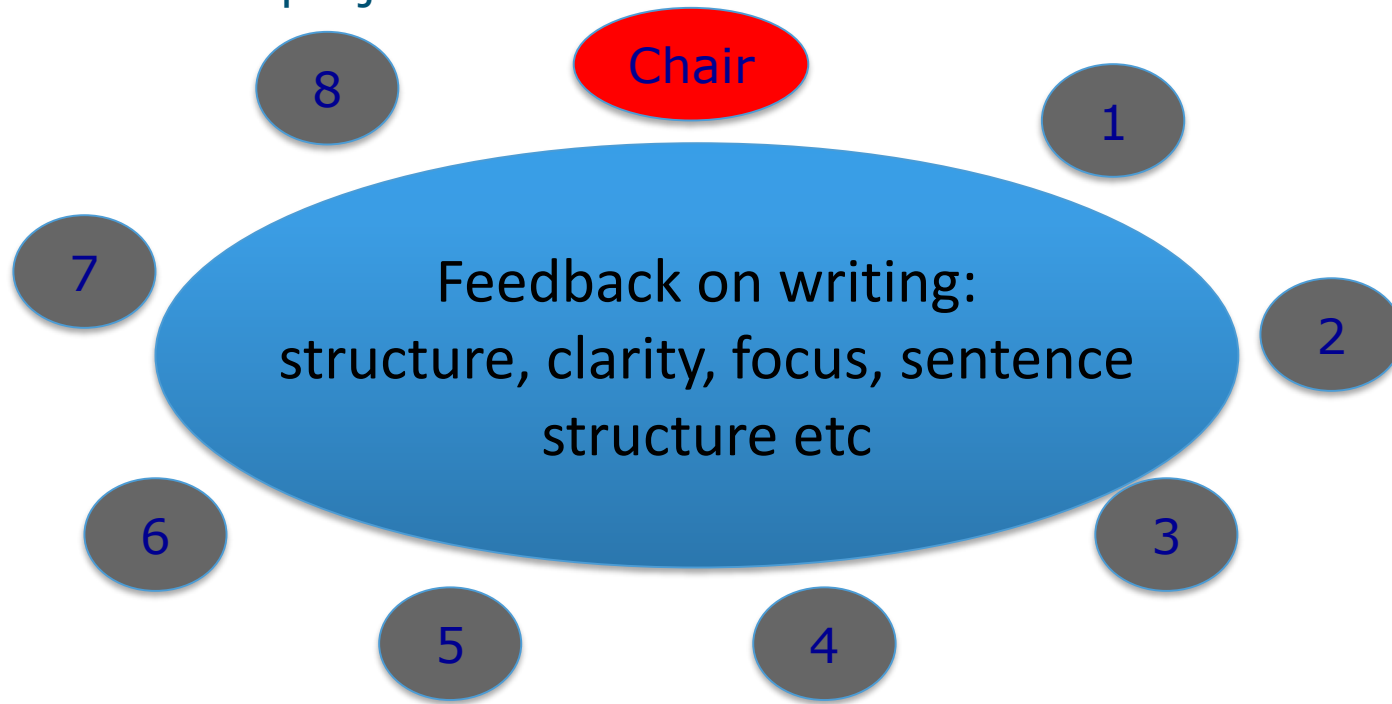
The thesis ring

Students:

- 8-10 in total
- A continuous group
- From different phases in their thesis project

Staff member:

- Chairs the meeting
- Will not read the documents
- Changes every study period



Organisation

- One session every week (1hr)
- 2 student contributions will be discussed
- Proposal-1 or 2
- Thesis report 3, 4 or 5
- The documents have to be handed in (on BB) 72 hrs (3 days) prior to the meeting
- All students read both documents prior to the meeting (Preparation time ~1-2hrs)
- During the meeting students will give constructive feedback to each other (according to the guidelines)



What can it bring you

- Feedback on your own documents before you hand them in to your supervisor
- Learn from your fellow students: this will help you to improve your own documents
- Students in a ring better stick to the time schedule (Nematology experience)
- Broader view on nutritional field by reading results from other studies from chair group.

What does it take

- Meeting 1 hr every week
- 1 (max 2) hrs preparation time
- On a voluntary basis, but:
- **Full commitment is expected!!**
 - Sign up: Hand in documents (via BB)
 - Read documents in advance
 - Be present
 - Give positive and constructive feedback
