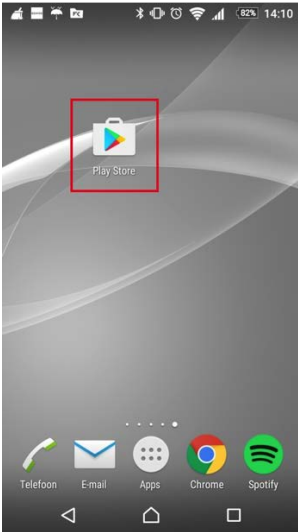
To use My Workspace, you will need to install the VMware Horizon Client. This manual explains how you can install the VMware Horizon Client and launch MyWorkspace from an Android device.

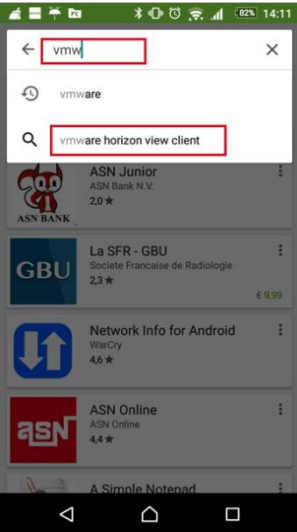

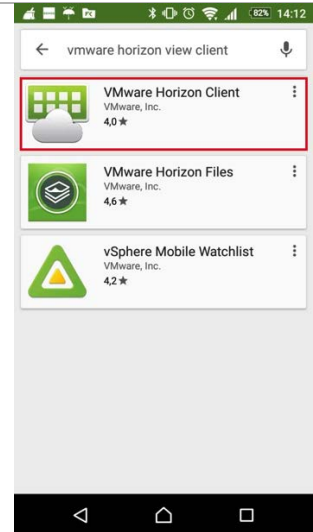
Open the Google Play Store.



Type "vmware" in the search bar and select "vmware horizon view client".



Select "VMware Horizon Client", Please note that the icon now looks like this:



Step 4 Step 5 Step 6

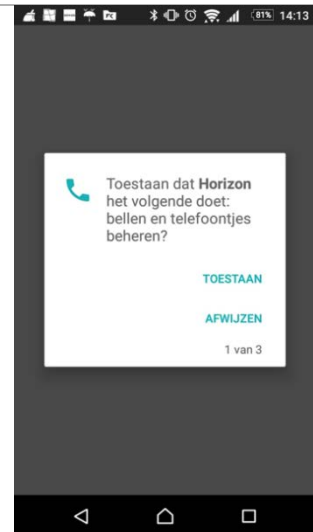
Click "Install".

Determine what type of access "Horizon" will have. Choose either Allow or Deny.

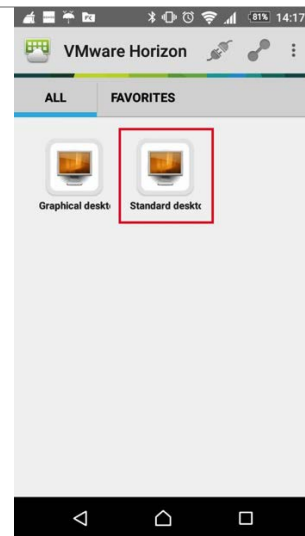
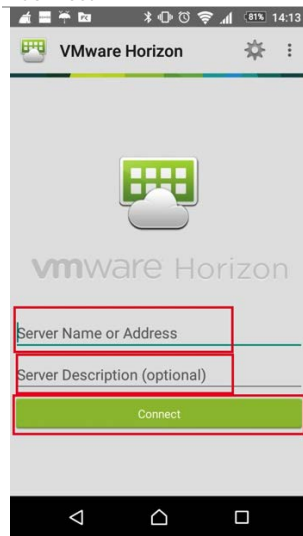

Select the desktop you wish to use to connect

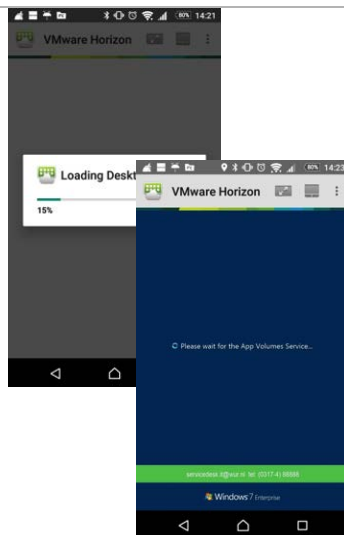
