
BRIEF HISTORY

of Viadrina

- 1506 1811: First public university of the principality of Brandenburg (Alma Mater Viadrina)
- 1945: Potsdam Treaty declared post-war border, dividing Frankfurt/Oder into Polish Słubice and Frankfurt/Oder (then part of communist GDR)
- **1991:** Foundation of the European-University Viadrina
- 1998: Inauguration of the Collegium Polonicum in Słubice
- 2007: Poland became part of Schengen no border control between FF/O and Słubice
- 2016: 25th anniversary of the European University Viadrina

- English B2 (or higher) **OR** German B2 (or higher)
- We do not require language certificates and trust the partner universities to pick students with sufficient language knowledge.



SUPPORT AND SERVICE

- Viadrina International Affairs supports students before and during their studies
- **Tutoring System** the student association "Interstudis" (ESN) will provide you with a tutor (including e.g. pick-up service, administrative issues, any university matters)
- About 6500 students
- good student teacher ratio

COST AND FEES

- Viadrina has no tuition fees
- Low cost of living (approx. 650 EUR/ month)
- Administration Costs: approx. 250 EUR per Semester
 - Semester ticket for public transport in Brandenburg and Berlin included!
 - Valid for 6 months (trains, trams and busses)
- Student Housing (per month)
 - 190-280 EUR student dormitory in Frankfurt/O
 - 200-400€ single rooms and shared apartments in Frankfurt/O.
 - 350-515 PLN (81-119€) student dormitory in Słubice (Poland)
 - 300-500 EUR shared apartment (no dorms) in Berlin
