Fee Pre-Master's programme

Academic year 2019/2020





Students who cannot be directly admitted to a Wageningen University master's study programme because of deficiencies in their previous completed bachelor education, may eliminate these deficiencies by following a premaster's programme ('schakelprogramma') prior to their master programme. A Wageningen University pre-master's programme consists of a maximum of 30 credits and is determined individually. The programme has to be completed within one academic year.

Students who enrol for a pre-master's programme pay a fee equal to the proportional part of the statutory tuition fee. The pre-master's programme fee for the academic year 2019/2020 is 1/60th of € 2083.00 per credit.

For example:

Number of credits in programme	Fee
30 EC	€ 1,041.00
24 EC	€ 823.20
18 EC	€ 624.90
15 EC	€ 520.75
12 EC	€ 416.60

Please note:

- You must pay the pre-master's programme fee before you can be enrolled as a pre-master's student.
- It is not possible to pay the pre-master's fee in instalments.
- There will be no restitution of the fee paid, should you decide to terminate your enrolment as a pre-master's student before you have obtained the credits you have paid for.

If you want to take additional subjects (other than in your programme), then you will have to enrol as a regular bachelor student and pay the tuition fee according to your situation, taking the nationality and degree requirement into consideration. Or, you can register as a contract student for the additional courses. Please see the information on tuition fees 2019/2020 for bachelor students or contact the Student Service Centre (ssc@wur.nl).
