# Estimate of costs BSc study 2019-2022

A BSc study at Wageningen University will take at least 3 academic years. Students from an EU or EFTA<sup>1</sup> country should take into account that three years of bachelor's study will cost approximately €41,500.00.

The estimate of costs presented below is based on three years of study for a student who is eligible to pay the statutory tuition fee.

**Tuition fees:** The statutory tuition fee is determined by the Dutch government each year. You are eligible to pay the statutory tuition fee, if you meet the nationality and the degree requirement. Please see the factsheet 'Tuition fee 2019/2020 – which tuition fee do I have to pay' for further information on tuition fees.

The statutory tuition fees for the academic years 2020/2021 and 2021/2022 are not yet known and will be determined in August 2019 and August 2020 respectively.

Academic year 2019/2020: statutory tuition fee = €2,083.00

Academic year 2020/2021: statutory tuition fee = €2,110.00 (estimate)

Academic year 2021/2021: statutory tuition fee = €2,200.00 (estimate)

**Living expenses:** The minimum amount you will require for living expenses is approximately €900.00 a month. This includes housing (approx. €400.00 a month), food, books and study materials. Students who arrive in Wageningen mid-August will require an extra half month, €450.00, for living expenses.

**Insurance:** Another expense to consider is insurance for health and legal liability. Students with a European Health Insurance Card are only required to arrange legal liability insurance - this can be arranged by Wageningen University.

Estimated total costs for 3 years:

Tuition Fee	: €6,393.00
Living expenses	: €32,850.00
Health insurance	: €2,250.00

The estimated total costs for students with a EU or EFTA nationality who are eligible to pay the statutory tuition fee in the Netherlands are €41,463.00. This does not include travel to and from the Netherlands. All the above-mentioned amounts apply to students starting September 2019 and may be subject to change.

The tuition fee is paid per academic year. As mentioned above, the tuition fees for the academic years 2020/2021 and 2021/2022 will be determined by the Dutch Government in August 2019 and August 2020 respectively.

Payment in a currency other than euro's should be equivalent to the above amounts (differences in exchange rates are not acceptable).
