

Dear teachers,

During the corona press conference of the government on January 25 several relaxations were announced. In this letter we inform you on changes that impact our education.

Medical mouth-nose mask

In the last letter it was announced that wearing a (medical) mouth-nose mask is mandatory at all times in all university buildings. As of Wednesday January 26, wearing a mouth-nose mask is no longer required when seated and keeping 1.5-meter distance. So, students can take off their mask during exams, when an invigilator is not within 1.5-meter distance.

Teaching without a mouth-nose mask in front of the class was already allowed.

Medical masks are provided at the receptions for both students and teachers.

Binding Study Advice (BSA)

Just like last year, the BSA norm for first year bachelor students will be altered to 30 credits instead of 36. The pre-advice for students will remain 18 credits and will be provided at the end of period 4.

Vaccinate or booster without an appointment

On Thursday 27 and Friday 28 January from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. it is possible to get vaccinated or get your booster in Sports Pub de Bongerd without an appointment. We stimulate students to get a booster. See more info at prikkenzonderafspraak.nl.
