Note 1:

The general requirements for all Canadian diplomas apply only to diplomas which are obtained after having followed the provincial curriculum for at least 2 years. Diplomas obtained after only taking for example the final year in one of these curricula will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.

Overlapping subjects (e.g. AP Calculus AB and AP Calculus BC or AP Physics 1 and AP Physics 2) are not considered as individual subjects, they will be counted as one AP exam
