OA publishing is becoming increasingly important: major research funders require it and WUR has recently updated its OA policy. But why is OA publishing important and which options do you have? What are Creative Commons Licenses and which one is suitable for you? How can you identify predatory journals? This presentation will discuss recent OA developments, need-to-know information and practical tools. Join us and find out!
