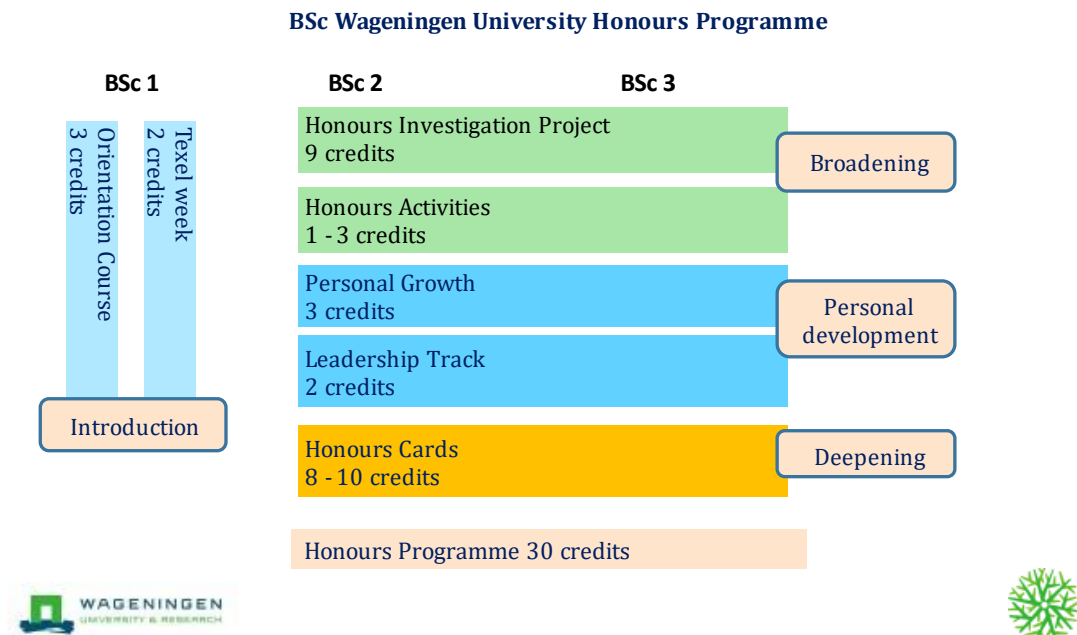


Instructions for Candidate students of the BSc Honours Programme

The BSc Honours Programme is for students who want and are able to go the extra mile. The Honours Programme is extra-curricular and on top of the regular bachelor study programme. It has a workload of 30 ECTS. There is one Bachelor Honours Programme for the entire Wageningen University. The Honours Programme exists of three components: broadening, deepening and personal development.



Honours is looking for highly motivated, creative and excellent first year bachelor students with a broad interest in the domains of life sciences. The BSc Honours Programme has set the following application criteria which have to be met in order to apply for the programme:

- First year bachelor student Wageningen University
- Special interest in deepening, broadening and personal development
- Ambitious, active and open-minded
- Distinctive extra activities (sport, music, art,.....) outside high school or bachelor
- Excellent student (grades at high school, minimum 7 out of 10)

If you want to apply, we expect the following from you:

- Letter of motivation (in English or Dutch)
 - Which specific interests do you have in the honours programme
 - What would you like to learn in the honours programme
 - What can other honours students learn from you in the honours programme
- Curriculum Vitae (CV)
 - Name, student registration number, mobile number, mail address, nationality, date of birth
 - Education: (current BSc programme + grades, other relevant education)
 - Experiences outside secondary school, university (volunteer work, work experience).
