

Home Work Facilities Regulations

The Home Work Facilities Regulations are a WUR elaboration of the facilities for working from home as laid down in the new CLAs WR/WU. They support hybrid working within WUR. The scheme has been approved by the COR and recently adopted by the Executive Board.

This arrangement includes the conditions for working from home (also for after covid) as well as the associated facilities. Think of the layout of the workplace and the home working allowance.

If the manager has agreed to the employee's request to work at home (or elsewhere) and if the employee works from home for at least 2 consecutive hours, the home workplace must meet the conditions set out in Article 5 of the Home Work Facilities Regulations. For this, WUR makes office furniture with accessories available to the employee concerned via an order portal. This order portal is expected to be available in early January.

The publication versions of this regulation will soon be available on the intranet. As soon as the office furniture order portal comes online, this will be communicated.
