

Instructions for candidate students of the BSc Honours Programme

The BSc Honours Programme is for students who want and are able to go the extra mile. As a motivated student, you are given the opportunity to further develop your talents and interests both within as well as outside your study domain.

We are looking for highly motivated, creative and excellent first year bachelor students with a broad interest in the domains of Wageningen University. The BSc Honours Programme has set the following application criteria's which have to be met in order to apply for the programme:

- First year bachelor's student at Wageningen University
- You are ambitious, active and open-minded
- Excellent student (grades at high school ≥ 7 out of 10)
- Distinctive extra activities outside high school and/or current study programme
- You have a special interest in a theme related to the mission of Wageningen UR

To apply we expect the following from you:

- Letter of motivation (max. 1 A4 (300 words)/ in Dutch or English)
- Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- Certified copy of your final exam grades at high school + average grade (1-10)

You are asked to combine the files into one PDF file: letter of motivation, CV, list of grades. (www.pdfmerge.com). Provide this document with your first and last name, as well as your WU registration number.

Letters of Motivation should include at least three aspects:

1. Which specific interests do you have in the BSc Honours Programme?
2. What would you like to learn in BSc Honours Programme?
3. Specify your interest in a theme you would want to work on in the Honours Programme.

CV should include at least:

- Personal information:
 - WU-registration number
 - Name
 - Telephone
 - Email
 - Date of birth
 - Nationality
 - Gender
- Education
 - Current BSc Programme
 - Other relevant education / training
- Experience outside secondary school / BSc programme
 - Internships / apprenticeships / work experience
 - Volunteer work
 - Other activities (e.g. class / school representative, cultural performances, starting an own business, etc.)
