# The Green Man

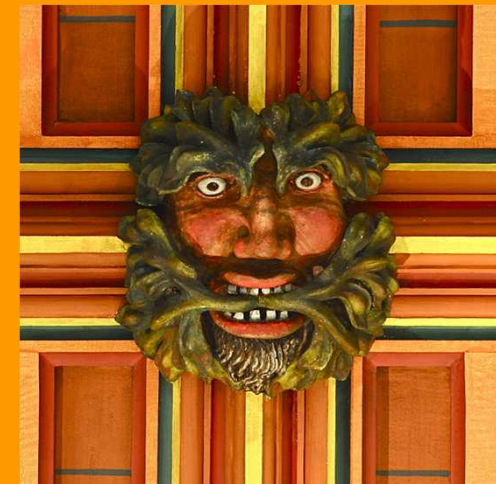
pagan perhaps a fertility figure or a nature spirit,

# Isis and Nephthys
