

How to connect to the WUR Wireless network with your Eduroam user account

This document describes a OSX operating system with a standard Apple supplicant.

Introduction

“Eduroam (education roaming) allows users (researchers, teachers, students, staff) from participating institutions to securely access the Internet from any eduroam-enabled institution. The eduroam principle is based on the fact that the user’s authentication is done by the user’s home institution, whereas the authorisation decision allowing access to the network resources is done by the visited network.” For more information about Eduroam please read the information on www.eduroam.nl.

Requirements

- An EDUroam-enabled user account.
- Make sure your wireless network card is switched on.

Guide

1. Turn *Airport* on and select *Join other network*
2. Either select ‘*eduroam*’ or enter ‘**eduroam**’ as network-name
3. Security = *WPA2-Enterprise / EAP*
4. Log on with your full username you have at your institute (usually this is the email address you have at your institute).
5. Accept the Go Daddy Class 2 Secure Certificate from the security.wurnet.nl server

Please do note:

- a. You must logon using the logon name as provided to you by your organisation.
- b. Your organisation must be an EDUroam participant: check at the IT department from your organisation for more information.
- c. Wageningen UR is an EDUroam participant and provides wireless connection according to the requirements by EDUroam.

We do not facilitate troubleshooting on non-WURnetaccounts since they are not managed by us: you need to contact the IT department from your own organisation for questions on using EDUroam.

You are now connected to the EDUroam wireless network.
