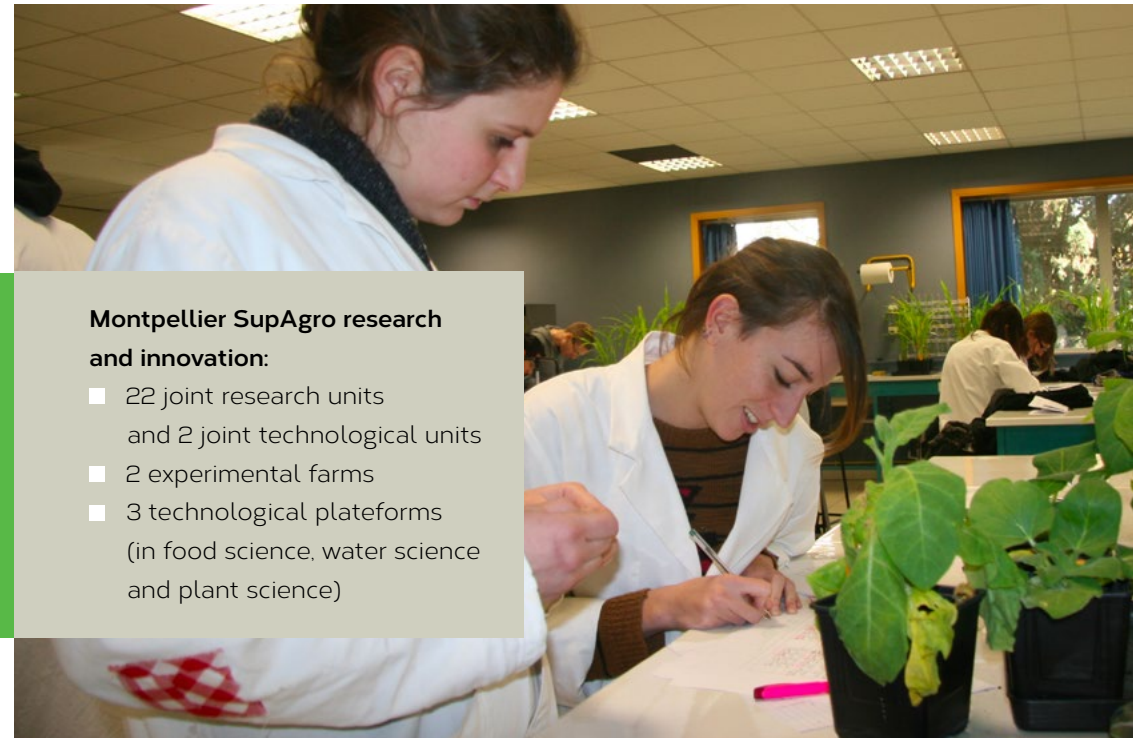

- EU ECTS credits system: 1 Semester = 30 ECTS
- Academic Level: junior or senior students – 400-600
- Deadline for application: 15 October
- Students should be nominated by their home university.

Each nominated student will receive an email with his/her login and password for the completion of his/her online application form : ID-photo, ID-document, transcript of higher education records, language certificates in French and/or English, depending on courses, cover letter and learning agreement.

INTERNSHIPS

ECTS depend on internship period.

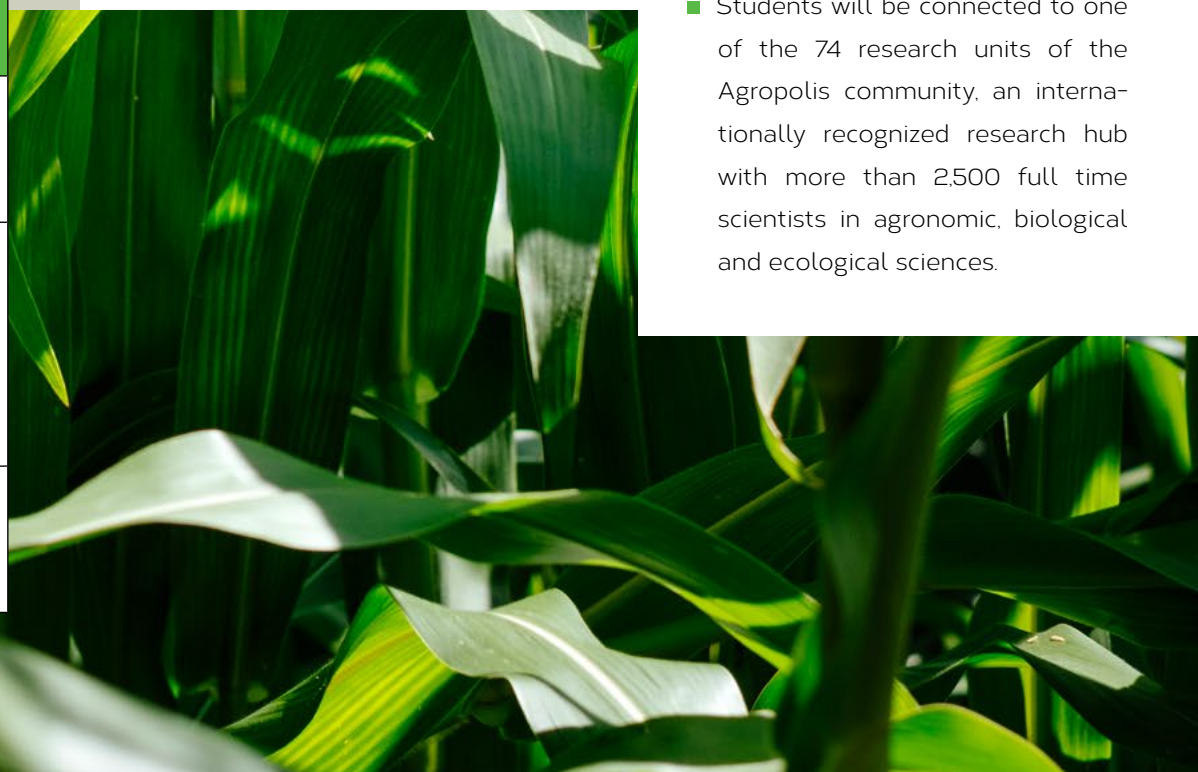
International students can also apply for a research internship in one of the 22 Montpellier SupAgro Joint Research Unit (UMR).

- Internship can begin at any time of the year.
- Internship may last from 2 to 6 months. Internships of more than two months are paid but more difficult to obtain.

JUNIOR RESEARCH LAB

6/8 ECTS

- From May to July the JRL will function as a real research unit.
- Small groups of 3-4 international students will be assembled on the basis of their complementary skills and they will have to identify a scientific question on which they will focus, learn by reading up-to-date scientific literature, design experiments, acquire and analyze data and write a scientific paper.
- Students will be connected to one of the 74 research units of the Agropolis community, an internationally recognized research hub with more than 2,500 full time scientists in agronomic, biological and ecological sciences.
