

## Charging stations on campus

Charging stations for electric cars, electric bikes and scooters have been installed on the Wageningen UR Campus.

There are six charging stations at the car parks at De Born Oost (alongside Bronland/behind Atlas) and another six at De Born West (behind ASG). They are open to all members of the public who want to charge an electric car. The electric car charging stations are marked blue on the sketch below.

These charging stations are easy to use. You activate the charging posts and start the process with a charging pass. The costs are €0.25 per kWh. Charging passes are not issued by Wageningen UR. You can obtain one from the supplier of the charging stations ([www.thenewmotion.com](http://www.thenewmotion.com)), your automobile dealer, or any provider of electric transport.

There are also eleven charging stations for electric bikes and scooters campus-wide. These are marked red on the sketch below. You can charge your bike or scooter simply by plugging it into the socket. This service is free.
