



GUIDELINES

Outstanding Alumnus Award 2019

University Fund Wageningen (UFW) promotes and stimulates excellence at Wageningen University & Research (WUR) and the accomplishments of her alumni. Once in the three years the Outstanding Alumnus Award is awarded to a WUR alumnus or alumna who is at the height of his or her career and made a significant contribution to the domain of 'Quality of Life'.

Criteria for nominations

- 1) Nominee made an outstanding contribution to improving the quality of life within the domain of healthy food and living environment consisting of three related core areas:
 - Food and food production
 - Living environment
 - Health, lifestyle and livelihood
- 2) Nominee must be at the height of his or her career
- 3) Nominee has made a positive contribution to innovative development (recommended)
- 4) Nominee must have an academic title (ir, dr, BSc, MSc or PhD) at WUR

Who can nominate

- ✓ Candidates must be nominated by someone else, it is not possible to nominate yourself
- ✓ It is not possible to nominate two people for a shared award
- ✓ The jury is authorized to nominate candidates themselves

Nomination protocol

Nominations, including all required documents (see below: A, B), must be submitted via the digital form on our website: universityfundwageningen.eu/alumnusaward

Deadline is **1st of August 2019**

Documents:

- A) Resume of the nominee
- B) Motivational letter, according the four criteria above (max. 500 words)

Ceremony

The ceremony will take place during the Opening of the Academic Year 2019 – 2020, in September 2019. Besides a judicium and a certificate, the winner receives the sculpture 'Freedom' by sculptor Marian Spekrijse.
