

**Contract governing the transfer of seed of the CGN special collection of *Lactuca* spp. lines (CGNSC002)**

In promoting the use of plant genetic resources for food and agriculture, the Centre for Genetic Resources, the Netherlands (CGN) manages a special collection of SSD lines of *Lactuca* spp.

The undersigned, dr. T.J.L. van Hintum, representing CGN (hereafter Provider), and ..... , representing ..... (hereafter Recipient), agree as follows.

- 1. Provider makes the Material (see Appendix) available to Recipient for further research, breeding and training for food and agriculture under the terms and conditions contained in this contract, in addition to the terms and conditions of the Standard Material Transfer Agreement belonging to the Multilateral System of the International Treaty on Plant Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture (SMTA), which also apply to the transfer of Material covered by this contract.
- 2. Recipient is allowed to freely share the Material with its affiliated companies provided they are bound by the conditions of this agreement, and Recipient declares not to transfer the Material as such to third parties.
- 3. Provider will provide 20 seeds of each individual accession to Recipient.
- 4. Recipient will pay to Provider a sum of €..... (ex. VAT), for which Provider will provide an invoice.
- 5. Provider declares that it has full authority over the Material and that no third parties are known with potential claims on benefit-sharing following the use of the Material in research, breeding and training for food and agriculture, except for FAO acting as a third party in representing the International Treaty on Plant Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture.
- 6. Provider understands that the due diligence obligations of Recipient following from accepting the Material covered under this contract as contained in the EU Regulation 511/2014 on the implementation of the Nagoya Protocol in the European Union have been fulfilled by signing the SMTA of the International Treaty on Plant Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture.
- 7. This contract and the SMTA together provide all conditions applicable to the transfer of the Material.
