

## Add your IDs and publication lists to your profile on We@WUR

You can add different Author Identifiers, publication lists and social media profiles to your profile on We@WUR. Furthermore you can also highlight some key publications.

First go to the website of We@WUR [https://www.wewur.wur.nl/zoeken\\_naam/default.aspx](https://www.wewur.wur.nl/zoeken_naam/default.aspx).

When you are not logged in (this is the case when you work on a computer that is not connected to the WURnet of Wageningen UR), log in first. Now your personal profile appears. Nearly at the bottom of your profile page your publications are included. In the example below your Wageningen UR publication list is already included.
