








Procedure thesis work at ENP

- Intake: any time of the year
- First meeting with Supervisor: any time of the academic year
- Thesis ring participation: every two weeks
- Meetings with supervisor: every two weeks except during fieldwork
- Proposal presentation: about 6 weeks after start
- Fieldwork: 6-8 weeks
- Writing up: 8-10 weeks
- Final colloquium: at least 6 months after start
- Thesis assessment by supervisor and second reader (from ENP)
