Estimate of Costs Master's Study 2021-2023

A master's study at Wageningen University will take at least 2 academic years. Students from an EU or EFTA country¹ should take into account that two years of master's study will cost approximately €28,500.50.

The estimate of costs presented below is based on two years of study for a student who is eligible to pay the statutory tuition fee.

Tuition fees: The statutory tuition fee is determined by the Dutch government each year. The statutory tuition fee for the academic year 2022-2023 is not yet known and will be determined in August 2021.

Academic year 2021-2022: statutory tuition fee = €2,168.00

Academic year 2022-2023: statutory tuition fee = €2,200.00 (estimate)

The tuition fees are paid per academic year.

You are eligible to pay the statutory tuition fee, if you meet the nationality and the degree requirement. Please see the factsheet 'Master's students – Tuition fees 2021-2022' for further information on tuition fees and requirements.

Living expenses: The minimum amount you will require for living expenses is approximately €925.00 a month. This includes housing (approx. €400.00 a month), food, books and study materials. Students who arrive in Wageningen mid-August will require an extra half month, €462.50, for living expenses.

Insurance: Another expense to consider is insurance for health and legal liability. Student insurance is obliged, including health insurance. EHC card holders (European Health Insurance Card) must check the conditions and period of coverage in the Netherlands with their insurance company before leaving for the Netherlands.

Estimated total costs for 2 years:

Tuition fee	: €4,368.00
Living expenses	: €22,662.50
Health insurance	: €1,470.00

The estimated total costs of two years of study for students with a EU or EFTA nationality who are eligible to pay the statutory tuition fee in the Netherlands are €28,500.50. This does not include travel costs to and from the Netherlands. All the above-mentioned amounts apply to students starting in September 2021 and may be subject to change.

Payment in a currency other than euro's should be equivalent to the above-mentioned amounts (differences in exchange rates are not acceptable).
