Fees Pre-master's 2020-2021

Students who cannot be directly admitted to a Wageningen University master's study programme because of deficiencies in their previous education, may eliminate these deficiencies by following a pre-master's programme prior to their master programme.

A Wageningen University pre-master's programme consists of a maximum of 30 credits and is determined individually. The programme has to be completed within one academic year.

Pre-master's students pay a fee equal to the proportional part of the statutory tuition fee. Per credit point, you pay 1/60th of the statutory tuition fee 2020-2021 (=€2143); this equals €35.72 per credit point.

For example:

Number of credits in programme	Fee
30 EC	€ 1,071.00
24 EC	€ 857.20
18 EC	€ 642.90
15 EC	€ 535.75
12 EC	€ 428.60

Please note:

- PRE-MASTER'S STUDENTS DO NOT ENROL VIA STUDIELINK!
 After you have received the admission decision with regard to your application for admission to a master's study programme, please contact the Student Service centre (via ssc@wur.nl) and ask information on how to enrol as a pre-master's student for 2020-2021.
- You must pay the pre-master's programme fee before you can be enrolled as a pre-master's student.
- It is not possible to pay the pre-master's fee in instalments.
- There will be no restitution of the fee paid, should you decide to terminate your enrolment as a premaster pre-master's student before you have obtained the credits you have paid for.
- If you want to take additional subjects (other than in your pre-master's programme), then you will have to enrol as a regular bachelor student and pay the tuition fee according to your situation, taking the nationality and degree requirement into consideration. Or, you can register as a contract student for the additional courses. Please see the information on tuition fees 2020-2021 for bachelor students or contact the Student Service Centre (ssc@wur.nl).
