All Dentistry Incoming Students must have a B2 Spanish Level. All the Business Incoming must have a B1 English Level. • For Traineeships in Dentistry, Physiotherapy, Nutrition, Medicine and Veterinary, the exchange student must hold a B2 Spanish Level. • Additionally, we offer some courses in English “English Program”. • All our Masters are delivered through Spanish. Incoming students applying to a Masters at UCV are required to have a B2 Spanish level.
