



Dutch Working Party on Drying (NWGD)

The Dutch working party on drying (NWGD) stimulates the development and application of sustainable drying technology in the Netherlands. Since 1974, NWGD connects drying experts in the Netherlands. Since 8 January 2014 NWGD has become an independent society with a new organisation structure. With some additional support of the Netherlands Enterprise Agency NWGD will organise the following activities:

- Thematic excursions. During an afternoon or evening session experts give a lecture on location in combination with a visit to a company, production location or knowledge institute.
- Annual meeting, where you can bring in your opinion.
- A NWGD yearly symposium with updates on innovation and research projects in the area of drying within ISPT and Wetsus.
- Setting up our own NWGD website, a website from and for drying experts, with updates on research and development, contacts, subsidy trajectories, international developments, and possibly also 'best practices' and drying solutions.
- Moreover, NWGD took the initiative to set up expert groups. A first initiative is on 'sheet drying' aimed at sharing best practices in this area.
