STUDY PERMIT AND LEGAL RESIDENCE

EU/EEA citizens do not require a study permit to enter or study in Norway. However, they must register at www.udi.no (The Norwegian Directorate of Immigration) prior to arrival in order to finalize their permit registration after arrival.

Non-EU/EEA citizens must apply for a temporary residence permit for educational purposes prior to arrival to Norway. As per 01.01.2021 the cost to apply for a study permit is 4900 NOK.
