- The title of your presentation (this will not be changed afterwards on the website).

For the final presentations we have set the following time limits:

- Presentation of BSc/MSc thesis or internship: presentation max 15 min., discussion max 5 min.;
- Presentation of MSc proposal: pitch presentation max 5 min., discussion max 5 min.; Please be on time in the room, and bring your slides on a memory stick (USB) to put it on the computer. A memory stick is faster and more reliable than logging in on your account.
